ABOUT US

B.A.S.I.C.S International aka BASICS is a registered 501 C3 organization in the USA, a registered NGO (Non Governmental Office) in Ghana, and partners with AS4AK in Australia. The mission of B.A.S.I.C.S International is to break the cycle of poverty for socially and economically disadvantaged children from inner-city communities via financial and social investments, we provide education, education sponsorship, and social services, that nurtures the holistic development of a child which leads to self sufficiency.

Since the year 2000, B.A.S.I.C.S International has impacted over 300,000 women and children through community outreach, provided 2300 educational sponsorships, of which 1400 was provided to the girl child. We have provided shelter to over 30 at risk girls, provided scholarships to over 100 high school students, and made it possible for 5 (and counting) university graduates. We have opened our doors to over 1000 volunteers, that represent 21 countries, and fully funded 2 Fellowships to US University grads.


ZEN PETROLEUM CONTINUES ITS CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

NATIONAL TOILET DAY


